We are a small company, limited by guarantee and were formed to provide a legal entity to enable transactions for the benefit of Newenden Meadow. Our objectives are:

1. To promote the conservation, protection and improvement of the physical and natural environment of the area known as Newenden Meadow ("the Meadow") which is located in Newenden, Kent.
2. To provide access to Newenden Meadow for the benefit of the local community and visitors, but with guidance/signage to ensure the on-going protection of the habitat.
3. To create a framework for the restoration of Newenden Meadow to include:
 - a. No plants, other than those native to the UK, may be introduced into the field, unless advised by an independent expert in their field and agreed with the Committee.
 - b. Any work in the field must be overseen by the Field Manager (FM), including the planting and sowing of seeds.
4. To create a community of people supporting nature conservation and the goal by:
5. Holding regular talks and events on nature conservation, particularly on the meadow habitat.
6. Engaging with the community to seek ideas and contribution through regular updates and provision of contact details to solicit feedback and comment.
7. To advance the education of and raise awareness among people living in the area and others about environmental and ecological issues, with particular reference to the environment and ecology of the Meadow.
